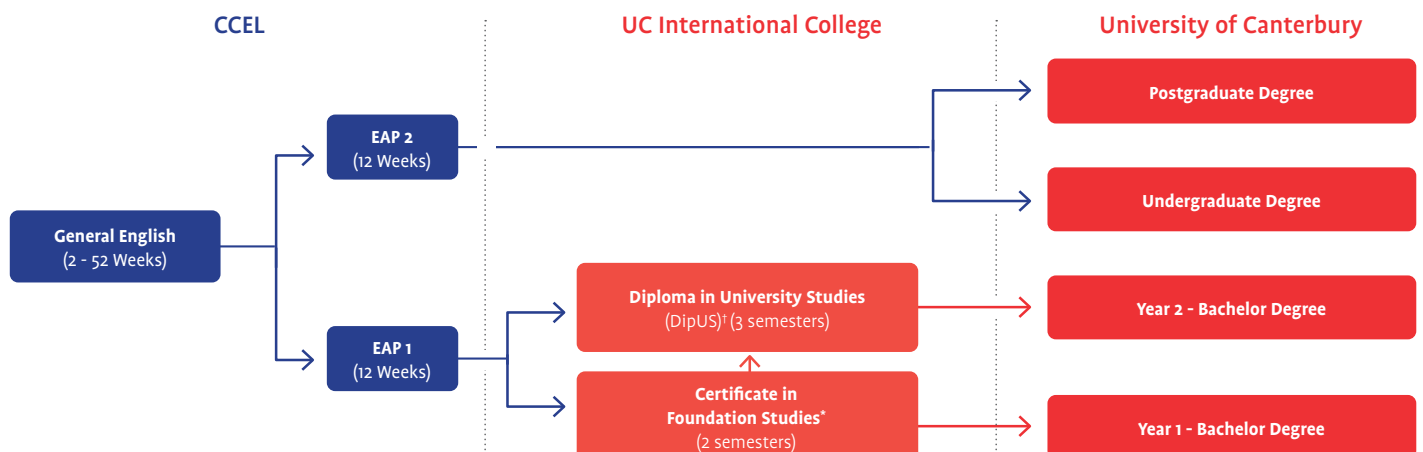
## CCEL's English for Academic Purposes 1 (EAP1)
